Our Re-opening Plans

From April 19th (start of summer term) indoor parent and child groups with up to 15 parents are allowed. We are therefore planning to re-introduce the programme of restricted number (less than 15 for us in order to maintain social distancing) parent and child 'stay and play' and other groups from this date and run these in similar format throughout the summer term. This will be kept under review and larger numbers might be invited to some events later in the term if it is considered safe to do so.
